AN ACT

Making appropriations for the Departments of Transportation, and Housing and Urban Development, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 ~~That the following sums are appropriated, out of any~~
4 ~~money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the~~
5 ~~Departments of Transportation, and Housing and Urban~~

7 ~~ing September 30, 2010, and for other purposes, namely:~~

1 Act of 1993 (42 U.S.C. 9816 note), of which not less than
2 \$5,000,000 may be made available for rural capacity build-
3 ing activities: Provided further, That \$8,000,000 shall be
4 made available for capacity building activities as author-
5 ized in sections 6301 through 6305 of Public Law 110-246.

6 HOMELESS ASSISTANCE GRANTS

7 (INCLUDING TRANSFER OF FUNDS)

8 For the emergency shelter grants program as author-
9 ized under subtitle B of title IV of the McKinney-Vento
10 Homeless Assistance Act, as amended; the supportive hous-
11 ing program as authorized under subtitle C of title IV of
12 such Act; the section 8 moderate rehabilitation single room
13 occupancy program as authorized under the United States
14 Housing Act of 1937, as amended, to assist homeless indi-
15 viduals pursuant to section 441 of the McKinney-Vento
16 Homeless Assistance Act; and the shelter plus care program
17 as authorized under subtitle F of title IV of such Act,
18 \$1,875,000,000, of which \$1,870,000,000 shall remain
19 available until September 30, 2012, and of which
20 \$5,000,000 shall remain available until expended for reha-
21 bilitation projects with 10-year grant terms: Provided, That
22 not less than 30 percent of funds made available, excluding
23 amounts provided for renewals under the Shelter Plus Care
24 Program and emergency shelter grants, shall be used for
25 permanent housing for individuals and families: Provided
