Dear Secretary Leavitt:

We are writing to adjust a geographic-specific provision included in House Report 108-792, the report accompanying the FY05 Omnibus Appropriations bill. This will not change the overall HRSA budget authority.

The funding is cited under Division E, Title II – Department of Health and Human Services – Health Resources Services Administration (HRSA). Page 1132 of the House Report 108-792 allocated \$150,000 to the Community College of Southern Nevada for a mobile dental outreach treatment and education program. We would like to request that the funding be awarded to the Nevada Health Centers in Elko, NV for the same program, commonly known as “Miles for Smiles.” The Nevada delegation has requested this adjustment in the fiscal agent for this provision.

Thank you for your prompt attention to our request and we look forward to hearing from you.
